We hope everyone in the Saxony community is continuing to stay healthy and staying home for a little while longer per current State and County orders. We also hope the Spring weather is a bit of a lift for home-bound spirits.

Bloom Floralscapes ("Bloom") has begun their Spring clean-up; there are some areas still to be done. Bloom has tested the sprinkler system, which will be turned on for the season sometime in the next couple of weeks. The annual flowers will be planted when the sprinklers are activated, currently scheduled the week of May 11. Timing depends on the potential for freezing temperatures. Saxony's regular grass-mowing day will be Monday. A walk-through is scheduled for next week to check landscaping needs and assess any damage after the Winter season.

Fielding Tree completed plant chemical treatments for 2020. A walk-through with Fielding will be scheduled to check tree conditions after all trees have leafed out.

This week there has been some different kinds of activity in the neighborhood. Comcast laid new cable along the stucco wall on the east side. Arapahoe County cut down and removed dead trees from the Caley median. What happens next with the median remains to be determined.

Thank you to those neighbors who responded positively to Saxony manager Dave Littler's request to switch to automatic dues payments.
